
Thank you for supporting our Joe Corbi's fundraiser. We were able to raise over \$500!

SPRING RECIPES

Red Orange Sorbet

Ingredients

- 1 cup organic brown sugar
- 1 Tbsp. red orange zest
- 4 cups of freshly squeezed red orange juice with the pulp

Directions

- In a saucepan, combine one cup metal baking pan and place in the of red orange juice and sugar. freezer.
- Stir frequently over medium
- Combine the sugar and juice mixture with the remaining orange juice and zest
- Chill thoroughly in the refrigerator (about 2 hours).

Pour the mixture into a shallow

- · Stir the mixture every hour heat until the sugar is dissolved. • with a fork until it is completely frozen.
 - · Freeze until completely chilled (about 2 to 3 hours). It is best served within 2 to 3 hours of freezing.
