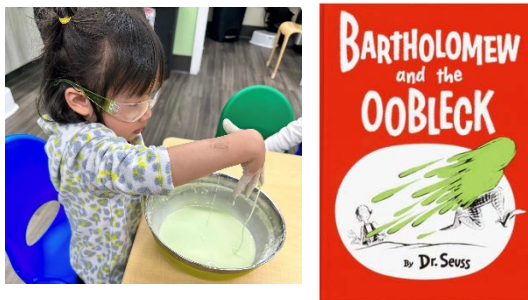
Infants

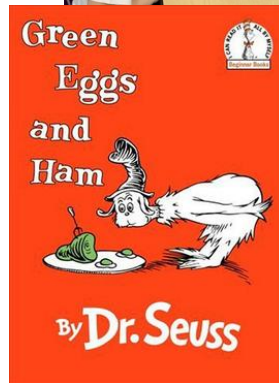
Toddlers

SAC 2 celebrated Valentine's Day with a clever project filled with love. <3

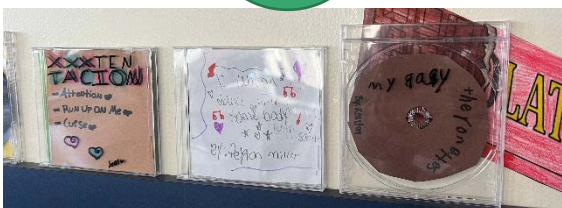
